Paper Mill Cleaning Applications

Boilouts


Boilout programs are the most common downtime procedures used to clean the internal surfaces of papermaking systems.

Key applications:

- Paper machine wet-end
- Stock preparation systems
- Coater systems
- Starches, pigments, binders, polymers dyes and other support systems

Benefits:

- · Improve sheet quality
- · Improve machine runnability
- Improve mill profitability



Bubble-Up®

The Bubble-Up is a unique process developed by DuBois to address the most critical deposit control area of the paper machine. A Bubble-Up is an internal foam cleaning of the approach piping, inlet manifold, headbox and slice lip.

Benefits:

- Targeted to areas where runnability issues generally begin
- Less time required than a boilout
- Higher concentration than a boilout with lower chemical use
- More flexibility to complete other outage maintenance during cleaning



Machine Surface Cleaning

Foam cleaning is a mixture of cleaning chemicals, water and air which adheres to the surfaces to be cleaned. The foam solution rinses freely with water after cleaning.

Gel cleaning applies a ready to use cleaning chemical solution. A thin gel coat can stay in contact with a surface for an extended period time (up to hours), and then rinses freely with water. Gel cleaning can be more economical and effective than other cleaning methods.

Benefits:


- Increased cleaning efficiency as the products cling to vertical surfaces and allows greater contact time
- Less backsplash than liquid products, and less chance for the user to contact the chemical
- Lower cost than other chemical cleaning methods or hydro blasting

Application areas include:

- Paper machine frames
- Rolls and forming elements
- Dryer cans and fabrics
- Coaters and size presses
- Stock, water and process additive chests
- Floors, basements and walking surfaces

Scale Control

Scales from barium, calcium, and sodium have a tendency to build in areas of high temperature.

Problems associated can be:

- Headbox buildup
- · Reduce flow control
- Reduce heat transfer
- Plugged shower nozzles
- Poor vacuum control

Sure Safe is a line of safer cleaners based on neutral or noncaustic raw materials. The line includes products that are noncorrosive to skin and eyes and therefore require less safety equipment when used.

The patented Neutra Solve line includes unique products specifically to remove paper mill stickies and other organic soils. The products have significant cleaning advantages over kerosene, mineral spirits or other hydrocarbon based solvents. They can provide cost savings, reduced VOC use and better flammability ratings than alternate products.

DuJel is a full line of gel cleaners that allow the cleaning product to stick to vertical surfaces, effectively allowing for extended contact time of the cleaner and the deposit.
